In accordance with Section 11.4 c. (v) of the Tri-Party Memorandum of Understanding for a Successor Facility to the Georgia Dome, we are pleased to present the required quarterly update.

The project continues to keep a keen focus on implementation of the Equal Business Opportunity Plan.

As this is the first report, a brief overview of the progress to date:

360 Architecture has been secured as the lead designer in cooperation with Atlanta based TVS Design, Stanley Beaman Sears (FBE) and Goode Van Slyke (AABE) on the architectural aspects of the NSP. The design team continues to be expanded into the other design disciplines as detailed in section I.

The Joint Venture team of Holder Construction Group, Hunt Construction Group, H.J. Russell (AABE) & Company and C.D. Moody Construction Company (AABE) to be known as HHRM were selected to provide construction services for the NSP.

Total Contracts awarded for the overall job represent 4.5%, with the vast majority of the contracts yet to be awarded. We remain committed to fulfilling the obligations set forth in the Equal Business Opportunity plan and will provide similar updates on a quarterly basis. 

Equal Business Opportunity Plan Compliance Protocol

Objective: Develop and execute a program in which 360 Architecture's (360) extended A/E team's goal is to successfully implement an Equal Business Opportunity ("EBO") Plan for enlisting and monitoring participation of local minority and female business enterprises ("M/FBE") relative to the design of the New Stadium Project ("NSP").

The following protocol reflects the actions to attempt to reach the collaborative goal set forth at 31% in the Equal Business Opportunity Plan:

Architectural Compliance: 360

developed and researched potential architectural partners that have reached out to us via phone or email and we have identified via the City of Atlanta, Office of Contract Compliance. 360 identified seven (7) select local and M/FBE firms with similar/ complementary culture, fit, capacity, personality and experience and made office visits on May 1 and 2, 2013. During the week of May 6th, three (3) firms were identified by 360 as "key partners" to share meaningful roles across various phases and scope. Two of the three firms selected by 360 as subconsultants are City Certified AABE and FBE firms.



360 and its key partners may work with contracted local firms to engage in a **Minority Intracompany Transfer Program (MITP)** in which an M/FBE architect/designer/engineer is entrenched into a local or national firm's office through a contractual agreement with the M/FBE firm. This accomplishes three goals:

- An opportunity for a staff member to contribute to a nationally recognized project.
- Project participation by an M/FBE, gaining the experience necessary for future opportunities.
- The team's attempt to reach the goal of the EBO.

If the need arises, 360 may contact a local M/FBE firm to discuss participation in the MITP in 360 Architecture's Kansas City office for a minimum of three months. The contractual agreement would be similar to the arrangement of the local firm with the exception of the M/FBE paying for the living expenses of the transferee.

Community Outreach:

- Thursday, June 20th - 360 collaborated with StadCo and participated in the City of Atlanta's 2013 **Back to Business Conference**, a "meet and greet" event that facilitated the introduction of local and M/FBEs. The list of firms on the sign-up sheet was distributed to consultants for review and to contact prospective teaming partners.
- Tuesday, July 9th - 360 and its local architectural consultants attended and presented the NSP at a "meet and greet" hosted by the Atlanta chapter of the AIA.

- Tuesday, July 30th - 360 hosted an **Architecture/Engineering Meet and Greet** to provide Architecture and Engineering firms the opportunity to learn more about the project, potential opportunities to provide their services and the process/procedures for consideration.

- 174 attendees signed the Meet and Greet registration sheet representing 136 firms.
- 53 of the 74 prequalification statement forms received were from attendees of the Meet and Greet.



Engineering Consultant Compliance:

- 360 and national specialty firms identified scopes and roles for potential opportunities to engage local firms to team. The firms reached out via the City of Atlanta's Prism website which provided the current list of certified M/FBE's firms. Meetings with qualified candidates were conducted. Recommended finalists were submitted for review and approval from StadCo in collaboration with the Lead Architect.
- Qualified firms that were not selected are placed in a database for future consideration of participation in the MITP.

Architecture and Engineering Team Summary

- Firms selected to date: 23 firms have been selected to be part of the Atlanta New Stadium Project Team, 15 (65%) of which are City Certified M/FBE
- Fee percentage: to date, M/FBE's fees account for approximately 22.6% of the fees established

360 Architecture and team members embrace the City of Atlanta's Equal Business Opportunity Plan and are fully committed in executing a plan that meets all team members' goals and objectives.
