DO'S

&

DON'TS



USE GPS

GPS and Mapping
Systems can be used as
long as they are not
held while driving.

SMART WATCH

You can wear and use a smart watch while driving.

USE EARPIECES

If your car does not have Bluetooth capability, you are allowed to use an earpiece to talk on the phone, but one ear only.

HANDS-FREE TECH

You can voice text and talk on speaker phone while driving as long as there is not physically touching or holding the phone.

EMERGENCY CALLS

You are allowed to physically hold your phone while driving if you are making an emergency call.



HANDLING PHONE

You cannot physically hold or support phone while driving, unless in a fully-parked position.

RECORDING VIDEO

Recording a video on your phone via
Snapchat or other programs is prohibited.

WATCH VIDEO

Watching a movie or video while driving is prohibited.

TEXTING

Writing, sending or reading text messages while driving is not allowed.

RESPONDING

You cannot use more than one button to answer or use phone.
