



## Georgia World Congress Center Authority Update on COVID-19

**(ATLANTA)** – The health and safety of our customers, guests, and team members is a top priority for Georgia World Congress Center Authority (GWCCA). Our Department of Public Safety – Office of Emergency Management (DPS-OEM) continues to work closely with the Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) and the Fulton County Board of Health to prepare for COVID-19, monitor local, state, and national developments, and take the appropriate health precautions.

With the support of state government, GWCCA remains open. However, the rapidly evolving situation around COVID-19 has resulted in the cancellation of shows planned at Georgia World Congress Center over the next several weeks.

GWCCA continues to exceed all recommendations by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for cleaning and disinfecting public areas and will continue to amplify public health messages as needed. We encourage all team members and guests to follow the guidance below:

- Adhere to social distancing recommendations
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60-95% alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or use a tissue to cover it, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
