In accordance with Section 11.4 c. (v) of the Tri-Party Memorandum of Understanding for a Successor Facility to the Georgia Dome, we are pleased to present the required quarterly update.

The project continues to keep a keen focus on implementation of the Equal Business Opportunity Plan (EBO). Currently, of the total \$64,826,200.39 contracted to date, nearly 26% has been awarded to our MFBE partners.

Since our last EBO Report #3, Griffin & Strong (G&S) has joined the team as our Diversity Coordinator. Their firm information page is in the developer section of this report. They are new to the team and will be ramping up their efforts as the project increases in activity. To date the total contracted amount has grown approximately \$30M since EBO Report #3. HHRM continues to populate and grow as procurement and construction begins for the NSP.

At the time of this report, Total Contracts awarded for the overall job represent approximately 7%, with the vast majority of the contracts yet to be awarded. This percentage mainly reflects the scopes of Architecture and Engineering. We remain committed to fulfilling the obligations set forth in the Equal Business Opportunity plan and will provide similar updates on a quarterly basis. 


