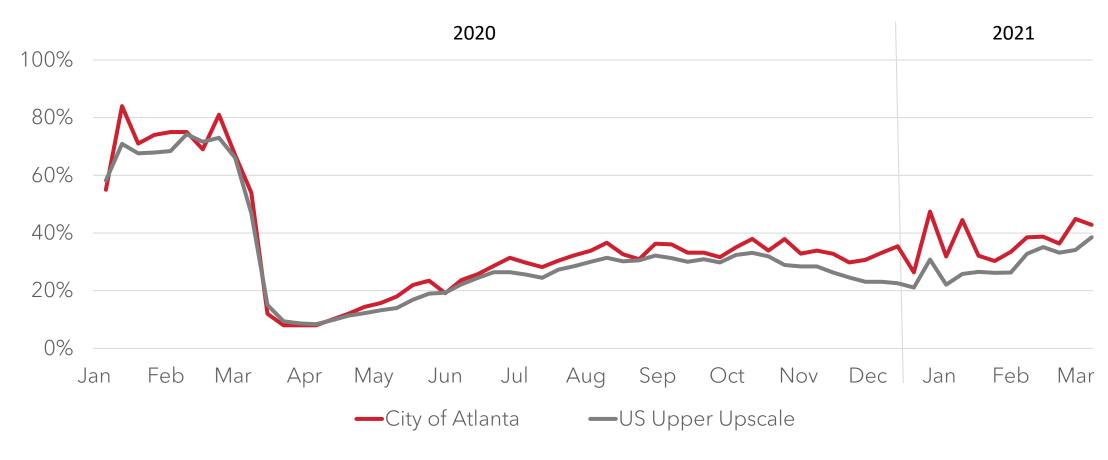

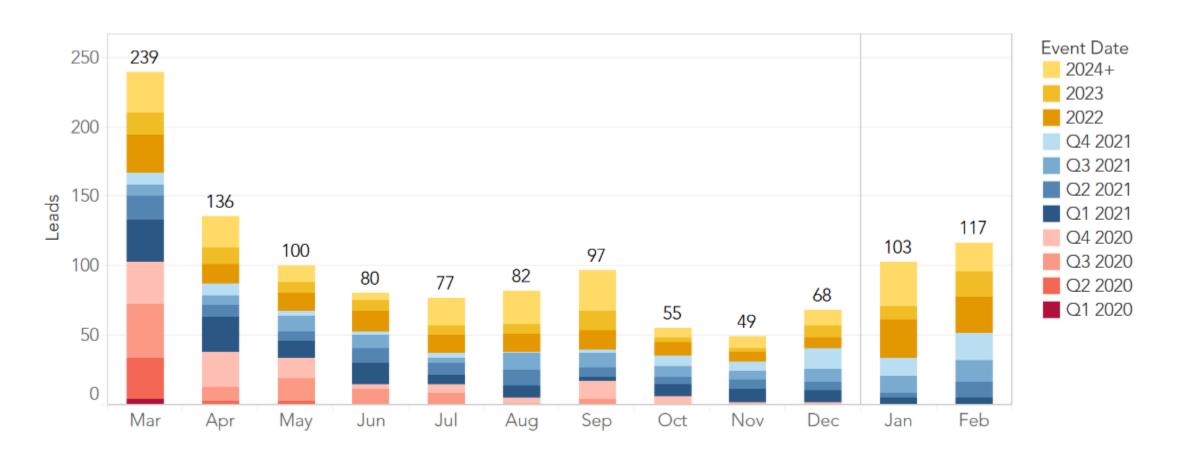
WEEKLY HOTEL OCCUPANCY

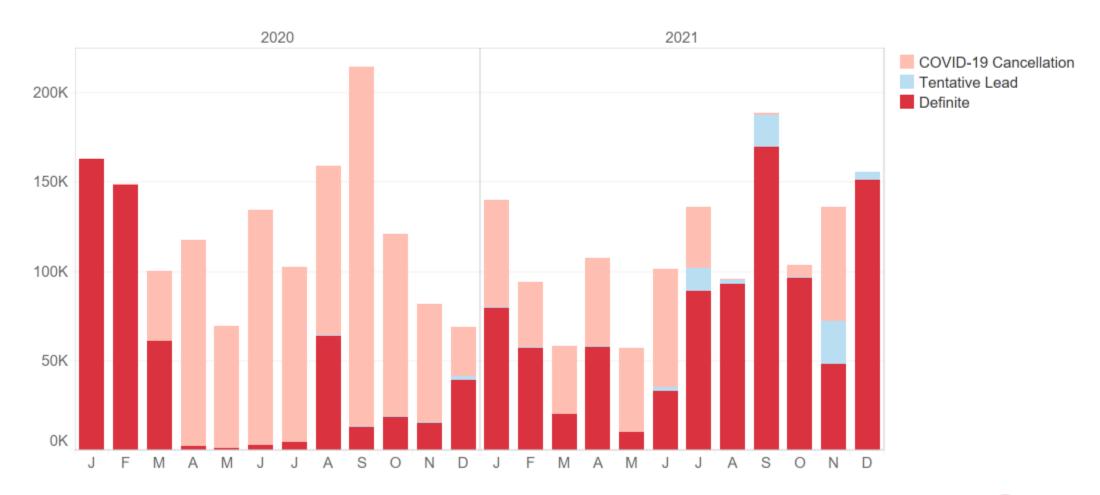

by Room Date and Status

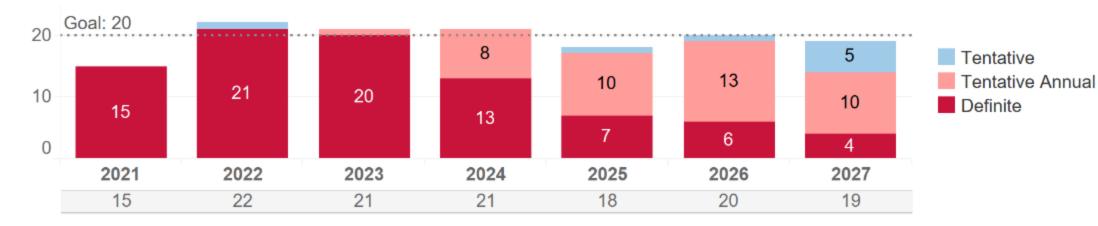




LARGE GROUPS FOR FUTURE YEARS

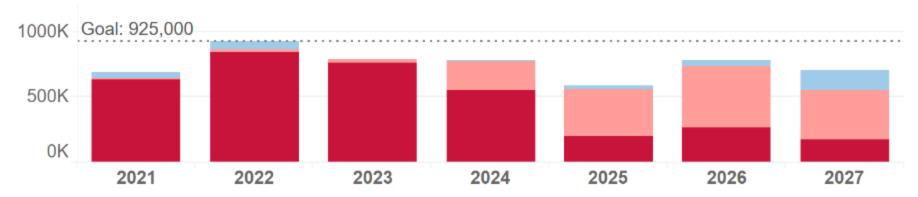

Background: Custodial Services



- As reported to the Board in February, a highest-ranked "Apparent Awardee" firm, American Maintenance, was selected by GWCCA's Selection Committee on February 19 from a thorough evaluation of five submitting firms
- A Fee Proposal was requested of and negotiations ensued. Careful attention has been paid to important issues, including event labor/non-event labor, transition plan including customer communication, and equipment evaluation/buyout

RFP Process and Timeline: Custodial Services



- Evaluation Committee Members: Joe Bocherer, Chris Chadwick, Ron Miranda, Jennifer LeMaster, LaTonia Ross, Patricia Richardson, Dominic Bruno
- > RFP was posted on December 17, 2020
- Finalist presentations were held on January 27, 2021
- ➤ Finalists performed operational audit on February 12 14, 2021
- ➤ References received from Orange County Convention Center, United States Tennis Association, Stoney Brook University
- > Evaluation Committee members finalized vendor selection on February 19, 2021
- ➤ Board updated on February 23, 2021

Negotiation: Custodial Services



- License Term: **Three (3) Years** with two (2) consecutive one-year options to extend agreement
- Estimate Annual Cost: \$4,400,000
- Customer Satisfaction At-Risk Fee: Contractor shall be required to offset its fees by 7% of aggregate amount if annual Qualtrics score is less than 4.0
- Contractor will purchase existing inventory for \$100,000 and supply \$130,694 in new equipment
