




GWCCA/GSFIC Projects








Orange Deck View from GWCC Building B











Andrew Young Int. Blvd. Pedestrian Mall Overall View

































































B4 Elevator Project Schedule & Logistics



Schedule Breakdown

- <u>9/28-10/9</u>
 - Most noise disruption
 - Remove car form Operation, Material delivery, demo old equipment
- 9/28-10/23
 - Most movement disruption from Mechanical room-TMB Fright-Loading Dock.
 - Equipment delivery and Demo haul out
- 10/29-11/4
 - Hoist way doors and hangers.
 - Working outside each elevator opening, installing new exterior doors, push button upgrades

- <u>10/26-11/25</u>
 - Majority of the work will be done inside shaft and mechanical room.
 - Cables, stripping, Cab install, fixtures, etc.
- <u>11/20-11/23</u>
 - Remove floor protection and barricades, pre punch work
 - Elevator adjustments, pit painting
- <u>11/30</u>
 - Project Turnover
 - Punch work

- Equipment delivery, demo debris and mics deliveries to be brought up by TMB freight elevator
- Dumpsters located at B Loading Docks
- Each elevator opening will have temporary barricades during project duration






Building B S4 AHU Units







2 GWCC - Large Blade Sign - Detail SCALE: 1" = 1'







